Ping Ouyang is original from Beijing, China, and performed as Post Doctoral Research Associate at the Ag Biosecurity and Forensic Laboratory. Dr. Ouyang got her Bachelor degree in Agronomy at the Beijing Agriculture University. Dr. Ouyang hold a Master degree in Agronomy and a Ph.D. in Human Nutrition from Kansas State University. She worked on biolistic bombardment and *Agrobacterium*-mediated transformation of wheat during her M.Sc. research, and focused on the effect of exercise-induced weight control on phospholipid profile and gene expression using mice as an animal model during her doctoral program. While studying, she was recipient of several scholarships, and winner of the Honorary Mention of the Coca-Cola Award at the Diet and Cancer Research Symposium Poster Competition during the American Society for Nutrition Meeting held in Washington, D.C. in 2007.
